Individuals who had contact with the confirmed cases

Home isolation for **14** days



Health Authority issues "Home (Self) isolation notice for contacts of 2019-nCoV confirmed cases."



Health authority surveils **TWICE** per day. **DO NOT LEAVE** home or the designated location.



If you develops symptoms, you will be referred to the designated medical facilities by Health Authority.

Those who fail to comply with command will be fined according to the Communicable Disease Control Act and may be proceeded with compulsory placement when necessary.



Travelers with travel history to China, Hong Kong, Macao, South Korea, Italy or Iran

Home quarantine for 14 days

(including **transiting** through China and through Hong Kong and Macao since 10th Feb.)



Authorities issue "Novel Coronavirus Health Declaration" and "Home Quarantine Notice." Wear a surgical mask when returning home for home quarantine.



Village leader or village officer surveils

ONCE to TWICE per day.

DO NOT LEAVE home or the designated location.



If you develops symptoms, you will be referred to the designated medical facilities. Health Authority will implement active health surveillance.

Those who fail to comply with command will be fined according to the Communicable Disease Control Act and may be proceeded with compulsory placement when necessary.

If I meet one of the following conditions:

- 1. Travelers with permission to visit Hong Kong and Macau
- 2. Reported case who is tested negative and met the criteria of de-isolation
- 3. Individual under community-based surveillance
- 4. Travelers arriving from countries under Level 1 and Level 2 travel warning

Self-health management for 14 days



AVOID going outside during the period of self-management.

If it is necessary to leave, please **WEAR A SURGICAL MASK**.



Check body temperature every morning and evening.
